Evaluation

The aim is to establish the functional level of the learner and to watch out for indications which could make further references necessary

- Establish the level on which the learner is functioning by using standardized tests
- During the evaluation the following could also be established:-
 - Visual perception
 - Auditory perception
 - Spatial orientation
 - Direction (reversals of letters and numbers)
 - Fine motor co-ordination
- When remedial tuition starts it is essential to start at the level where the learner experience success

Parent interview

- Be honest and sincere when the results are discussed with the parents
- Parents are usually upset and discouraged. Sympathetic and supporting guidance is necessary.
